

How to Identify a Partridge Pea Seedling Data Sheet.

Characteristics

- Round stem (can be rolled between fingers)
- Leaf-like stipules (small appendages at the base of the leaf stalk)
- Alternate leaves, each leaf has 8-24 opposite leaflets
- Pointed leaflet tips
- Nodules (round balls may be present) on roots
- One of the first native forbs to germinate in the spring
- Hairs on leaf stem (hand lens needed)
- Hairs on the edges of the leaflets (hand lens needed)
